The Independent Monitoring Board is a group of lay people from all sections of our community who wish to offer their time and expertise in the Monitoring of Prisons in Northern Ireland. As lead Catholic Chaplain can I encourage you to consider this role and apply. Fr. Stephen McBrearty. IMB members are unpaid public appointees, appointed by ministers to provide independent oversight of what happens in places of detention. It is a varied and rewarding role. You could be talking to a prisoner or detained person who is worried or vulnerable, who isn't able to access the support they need, or who needs help to sort out some practical problems.
