The Assisted Suicide Bill passed with a much narrower margin than expected in no small part due to church communities mobilising against the Bill. To ensure this Bill does not pass, continued opposition is needed. Past experience has shown that the volume of correspondence an MP receives from their constituents can sway their vote. "Not Dead Yet UK" is a disability organisation opposed to this Bill. They have produced post cards that an be sent directly to MP's to ask them to vote against the legislation of assisted suicide in the parliamentary vote at Third Reading. Bishop Alan has encouraged us all to send a postcard to our local MP's as the outcome of this vote will have implication in Northern Ireland. Postcards can be found at all the exits of the Church.
